OBJECTIVES

- Students will know different activities that take place on a farm.
- Students will be able to express an idea without using words.

PROCEDURE

- Copy each of the farming skills listed below onto small strips of paper.
- Divide the class into small groups.
- Give each group one slip of paper with a skill on it.
- Explain the meaning of charades.
- Have each group of students prepare a skit.
- Have each group perform their skit in front of the class.
- Have the students try to guess what each group is doing.

RECOMMENDED ASSESSMENT

- Ensure that students are not using words or sounds.
- Ensure that students are acting out the skill in an understandable manner.

EXTENSIONS

- Have a class discussion on other activities that occur on a farm.
