GRADES K - 1

MATERIALS

- dark and light green construction paper
- scraps of black and white construction paper
- scissors
- glue
- crayons/markers

STANDARDS

OBJECTIVES

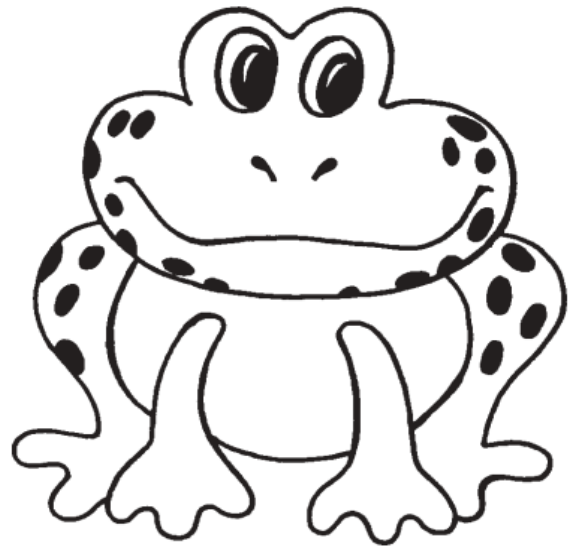
- Students will cut patterns on the lines.
- Students will refine drawing skills.
- Students will put pieces together to form a larger pattern.

PROCEDURE

- Have students cut out all the pieces.
- Have students trace the head, legs, and body on dark green construction paper and the stomach on light green construction paper.
- Have students cut the construction paper patterns out.
- Have students glue the stomach to the body, then the legs to the top of the stomach.
- Have students glue the head to the top of the body.
- Have students either cut the eyes out of white construction paper and the pupils out of black paper, or draw them on the head.
- Have students draw the mouth and nose.
- Use a green crayon or marker to make spots on the body and face.

RECOMMENDED ASSESSMENT

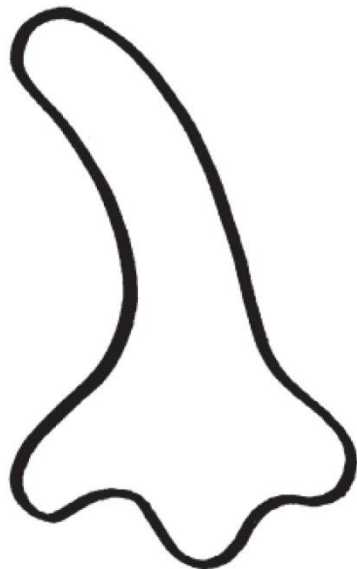
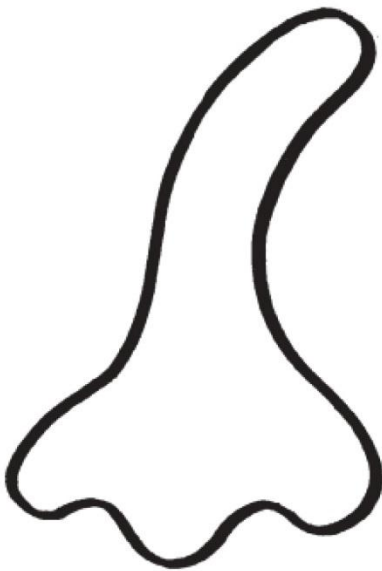
- Ensure the final product looks like a frog.
