The Lawrence A. Ackerman Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior based on the applicant's character, commitment to the stewardship of animals, financial need, scholastic achievement, and promise. Graduating high school seniors in Adams, Allen, DeKalb, Huntington, Kosciusko, LaGrange, Noble, Steuben, Wabash, Wells, and Whitley counties in Indiana are eligible to apply. A one-time \$2,000 scholarship will be awarded to one student each year.

To Apply:

Complete this application carefully and submit it with the following:

- An official transcript of your high school grades
- Two letters of recommendation by current or former employers, supervisors, teachers, coaches, or mentors.
- A one-page essay. Consider: (1) your proposed course of study related to the stewardship of animals, (2) your career objectives and how this scholarship would help you attain them, and (3) how your achievements, studies, and activities have influenced you.

Finalists will be invited to meet with the Scholarship Committee for an in-person interview on a specified date. <u>Application deadline is February 1.</u>



The Lawrence A. Ackerman Scholarship was established by the Fort Wayne Zoological Society in 1991 to honor the distinguished career of the late Dr. Larry Ackerman. In his 30 years of service in private practice and as the zoo's veterinarian, Dr. Ackerman became known for his professionalism, compassion, and generosity. Dr. Ackerman himself received some special financial assistance early in his college career. This scholarship will assist other deserving students in a similar way.
