OBJECTIVES

- When at the zoo, have the students look for animals that move in the various ways represented on the chart.

- Discuss with students the possible reasons why animals have different methods of moving through their environments.





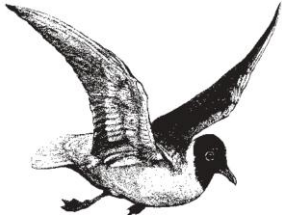

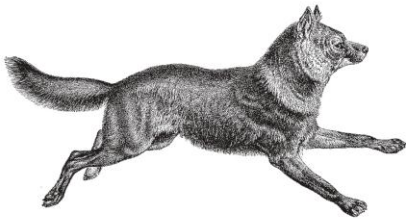

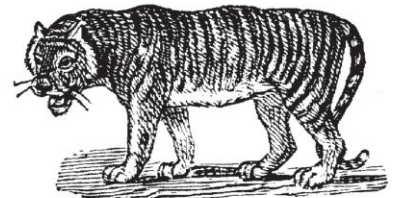

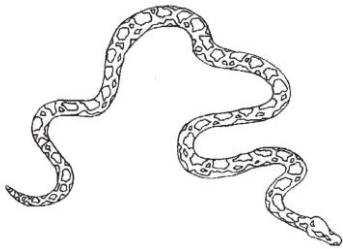
